





- ► Articulate a vision for a relationship with a higher education partner, including barriers and facilitators (e.g., feeling resistant, networking)

## Flashlight Approach

- ▶ What does a flashlight do?
- ► Focus on a one area to "shine the flashlight" instead of all areas at same time
- Measure and collect data for this one area (current or potential lesson/intervention)
- ▶ Use ASCA National Model's action plan throughout process
- ▶ Present findings to the school, district, and stakeholders
- ► Summarize findings, identify limitations and next steps

(Hatch, 2014)



- ▶ Barriers
  - ► Resistance
  - ► Conflicting goals/interests
  - ► Power
  - ▶ Cost
  - **▶** Communication



- ► Facilitators
  - ► Innovate within existing norms and valuates
  - Small increments of change
  - ► Align with leadership
  - ► Increase value/power
  - ► Change in times of crisis
